Ephesians 6:14 (NIV) — (14) Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place,

Psalms 51:1–6 (NIV) — (1) Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. **(2)** Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. **(3)** For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. **(4)** Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you are proved right when you speak and justified when you judge. **(5)** Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. **(6)** Surely you desire truth in the inner parts; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place.

Ephesians 4:14 (NIV) — (14) Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming.

2 Timothy 2:3–4 (The Message) — (3) When the going gets rough, take it on the chin with the rest of us, the way Jesus did. **(4)** A soldier on duty doesn't get caught up in making deals at the marketplace. He concentrates on carrying out orders.
