

## **The Freedom Bought By Jesus Christ.**

**John 8:31–38 (NLT)** — (31) Jesus said to the people who believed in him, “You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings. (32) And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.” (33) “But we are descendants of Abraham,” they said. “We have never been slaves to anyone. What do you mean, ‘You will be set free?’” (34) Jesus replied, “I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave of sin. (35) A slave is not a permanent member of the family, but a son is part of the family forever. (36) So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free. (37) Yes, I realize that you are descendants of Abraham. And yet some of you are trying to kill me because there’s no room in your hearts for my message. (38) I am telling you what I saw when I was with my Father. But you are following the advice of your father.”

### **I. What The Freedom In Christ Is Not.**

**Hebrews 12:8 (NLT)** — (8) If God doesn’t discipline you as he does all of his children, it means that you are illegitimate and are not really his children at all.

#### **A. What The Freedom Of Christ Is.**

**Galatians 3:10 (NLT)** — (10) But those who depend on the law to make them right with God are under his curse, for the Scriptures say, “Cursed is everyone who does not observe and obey all the commands that are written in God’s Book of the Law.”

**Colossians 1:13 (NIV)** — (13) For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,

**1 Corinthians 15:56–57 (NLT)** — (56) For sin is the sting that results in death, and the law gives sin its power. (57) But thank God! He gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ.

### **II. What Responsibilities Come With Christ Freedom.**

**Hebrews 10:19 (NLT)** — (19) And so, dear brothers and sisters, we can boldly enter heaven’s Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus.

### **III. How Christ Makes Us Free.**

**1 Corinthians 6:19–20 (The Message)** — (19) Or didn’t you realize that your body is a sacred place, the place of the Holy Spirit? Don’t you see that you can’t live however you please, squandering what God paid such a high price for? The physical part of you is not some piece of property belonging to the spiritual part of you. (20) God owns the whole works. So let people see God in and through your body.

**John 8:36 (NLT)** — (36) So if the Son sets you free, you are truly free.

### **IV. Why Does Christ Set Us Free**

**Galatians 4:7 (NLT)** — (7) Now you are no longer a slave but God’s own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir.
