

Time To Pray

2 Chronicles 7:14–15 (NIV) — **(14)** if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land. **(15)** Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayers offered in this place.

Judges 4:1–3 (NLT) — **(1)** After Ehud’s death, the Israelites again did evil in the LORD’s sight. **(2)** So the LORD turned them over to King Jabin of Hazor, a Canaanite king. The commander of his army was Sisera, who lived in Harosheth-haggoyim. **(3)** Sisera, who had 900 iron chariots, ruthlessly oppressed the Israelites for twenty years. Then the people of Israel cried out to the LORD for help.

Judges 4:21 (NLT) — **(21)** But when Sisera fell asleep from exhaustion, Jael quietly crept up to him with a hammer and tent peg in her hand. Then she drove the tent peg through his temple and into the ground, and so he died.

Zechariah 4:6 (NIV) — **(6)** So he said to me, “This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: ‘Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,’ says the LORD Almighty.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 (ESV) — **(17)** pray without ceasing,

Luke 21:36 (NLT) — **(36)** Keep alert at all times. And pray that you might be strong enough to escape these coming horrors and stand before the Son of Man.”

Acts 3:1 (NLT) — **(1)** Peter and John went to the Temple one afternoon to take part in the three o’clock prayer service.

Psalms 55:17 (NLT) — **(17)** Morning, noon, and night I cry out in my distress, and the LORD hears my voice.

Daniel 6:10 (NLT) — **(10)** But when Daniel learned that the law had been signed, he went home and knelt down as usual in his upstairs room, with its windows open toward Jerusalem. He prayed three times a day, just as he had always done, giving thanks to his God.

John 10:27–28 (NLT) — **(27)** My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. **(28)** I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me,

Revelation 3:10 (NLT) — **(10)** “Because you have obeyed my command to persevere, I will protect you from the great time of testing that will come upon the whole world to test those who belong to this world.
