
10/17/21 Radical Faith

Hebrews 11.1 "Now faith is the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen."

Matthew 6.30 "If God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and thrown into the furnace tomorrow, won't He do much more for you - you of little faith."

Matthew 8.23-26 "As he got into the boat, his disciples followed him. Suddenly, a violent storm arose on the sea, so that the boat was being swamped by the waves—but Jesus kept sleeping. So the disciples came



and woke him up, saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to die!" He said to them, "Why are you afraid, you of little faith?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm."

Hebrews 11.6 "Without faith it is impossible to please God, since the one who draws near to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek him."

3)	even when you don't feel like it. (Hebrews 11.27)
4)	it to experience it. (Matthew 12.34, Proverbs 12.14)
5) Mark 12.41-44)	even when you don't have it. (II Corinthians 8.1-5,
6)	God even before receiving it. (John 11.41)
7)	God even if you don't get it.
