Practical Steps to Overcoming Temptation

- 1 Realize that temptation is a spiritual battle and can only be won with God's help and intervention. (**Ephesians 6.10-18**)
- 2 Have a good understanding of what is right and wrong. (Seek spiritual counsel when you are unsure.)
- 3 Know for sure that you have been saved. (If unsure, please speak to someone who can help, like a pastor.)
- 4 Live with a fully surrendered heart towards God's will and God's way.
- 5 Believe that God would never require the impossible. (See I Peter 1.13-16 & Romans 6.1-2, 6-7, & 12-14)
- 6 Believe that God wants to help us overcome. (See Hebrews 4.16 & I Corinthians 10.13)
- 7 Avoid temptation when possible.
- 8 Rely on God's grace and power when you can't avoid temptation.
- 9 Make yourself accountable to others in areas of weakness.
- 10 Maintain a consistent devotional life.
- 11 Live with a mindset of victory, not defeat.
